Inspired by Cherriney W. Kondor's love for her fallen son, Specialist Martin W. Kondor, the Veterans Memorial Gold Star Healing and Peace Garden is a thoughtfully designed commemorative arboretum dedicated to all who serve in the United States Armed Forces. This living monument is a gathering place to honor all veterans, and remember the fallen in the war on terror.

The Gold Star Garden is designed in a circle to promote unity. A series of meditative spaces, the garden is arrayed around the central Field of Honor. Each area is a garden room planted with a particular color to represent a core value or character trait common to all members of the US Armed Forces.

Red represents Courage.

Orange represents Duty & Service.

Yellow represents Integrity & Remembrance.

Green represents Healing.

Blue represents Fidelity.

Purple represents Valor.

White represents Honor.

The Gold Star Garden makes tangible these core ideals and roots them in the ground allowing these noble characteristics to be expressed in living plants. Each room is connected to the central Field of Honor. The very center holds a bubbling fountain, symbol of renewal and refreshment. The Star Walk connects all core value

rooms to the center. On the arms of the Star Walk find the Wall of Valor holding the names of the fallen in the war on terror.

Designed as a place of active remembrance, the garden offers a space apart from the cares of this hectic world to remember, meditate upon and celebrate not only the fallen on the Wall of Valor, but all those who engage in action to provide solutions for the troubles of the world.

Journey along the Walk of the Intrepid through each garden room. One step at a time remember all those who serve, consider the core values and create new memories. Emerge from the garden feeling restored and full of appreciation for those engaged on behalf of the nation.
